VADM Rodney P. Rempt, Superintendent of USNA, **RADM Ronald A. Route**, President of NWC, and **RDML Patrick Dunne** met on April 8 to review analyses prepared by CIOs from their campuses. The university leaders agreed to a consortial approach and will meet again in August. A VTC with **Admiral Charles Munns**, Director of NMCI, was held on April 27. The NMCI Committee, chaired by **Dr. Peter Denning**, completed its work and briefed the **IT Task Force** on April 20, 2004. The **Faculty Council** will be briefed at its May meeting.

Church Computer Center**, senior military affairs journalist **Barbara Hoenneger**, and **LCDR Dave Nunnally** of the **Public Affairs Office** selected ten images most descriptive of the past 50 years of educational computing at NPS for an article in the upcoming flagship magazine *NPS Year in Review*.
